

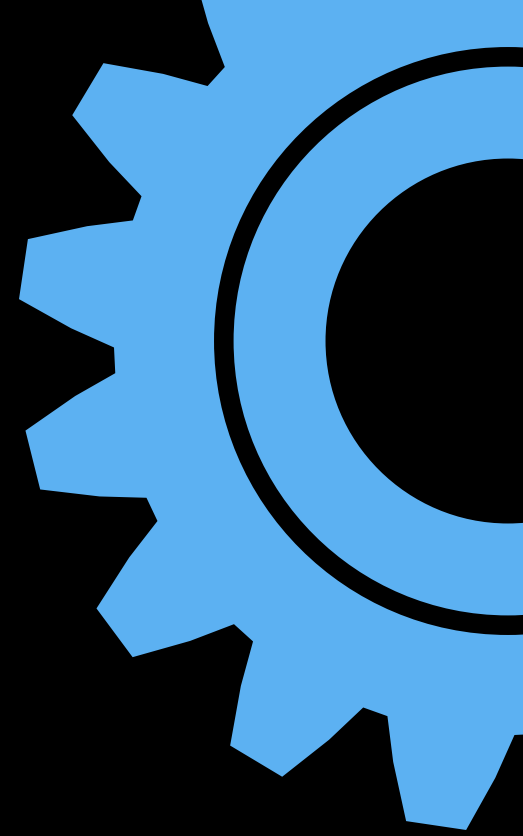
1. Be honest, fair and trustworthy in all of your GE activities and relationships
